All trainees must complete Building Analysis training through Conservation Services Group (CSG) which will educate the trainee on health and safety issues and conservation principles for home energy analyses. The two-week classroom and field training program is the first step toward Building Performance Institute (BPI) certification. Two written tests will also be required along with a field test to complete certification. New employees will then undergo six months of on-the-job training with Energy Management Solutions.

Home Performance Crew Leaders and Professionals

Must be able to climb ladders, enter attics, basements, crawl spaces, and roofs. Must have basic math, computer, and e-mail skills. Must be able to use various testing equipment, and use basic tools. Must have own transportation and a valid clean driver's license. Must be able to install light bulbs, shower heads, thermostats, do basic wiring, caulking, and blown in insulation. Crew Leaders must exhibit leadership and teaching abilities and have solid experience.

Electrical Light Reduction Assistant

Trainees work directly with an experienced electrician to be taught everything needed to effectively cut lighting cost by up to 70%. ELRAs will have the opportunity to become a Crew Leader as a lighting electrician which could grow into a management/training position.

Electrical Assistant

Must be physically fit in order to climb ladders, and work in high places. Must not be afraid of electricity, as position entails working with lighting fixtures. Must want to become an electrician.

Sales Professional

Must like selling and have basic sales experience. New Sales Professionals are taught, over a six month training period, all the energy saving concepts and sales techniques so that services can be properly communicated to potential clients.

Applications are available in the Resource Room at Tomorrow's Workplace. Candidates must complete an application which will be pre-screened by Tomorrow's Workplace. Résumés are optional but recommended; however résumés will not be accepted in place of an application.
